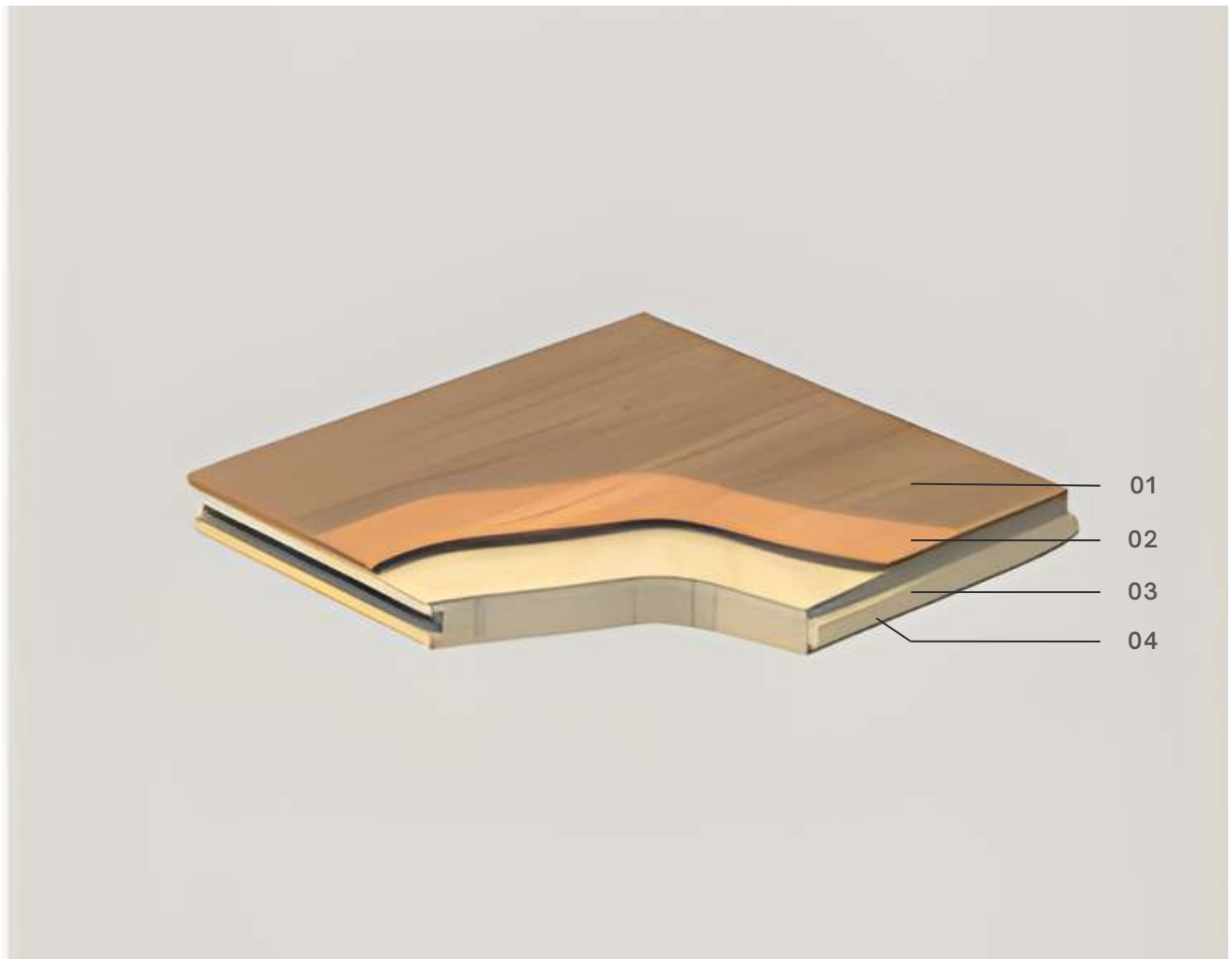


The Current Scene with Engineered Wooden Flooring

However, not all engineered floors are the same; factors like wood grade, top veneer thickness, wood species, construction type, and installation method significantly impact quality and therefore, price. We simplify this complex information to help you make an informed, long-lasting investment.

Structure of Engineered Wood Floors



1. Surface Finish: Hardwax Oil/ UV Oil / UV Lacquer.

2. Top layer - This is made from real wood and the thickness ranges from 2mm - 3.2 mm.

3. Core - Solid Wood / Multi Ply.

4. Bottom Layer - Solid Wood / Multi Ply.

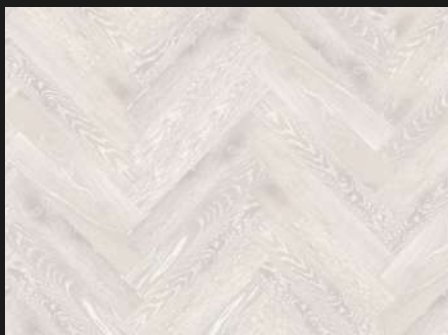
Lighter-tone wooden flooring can have a significant impact on interior design. It can make a space feel more open and bright and can create a modern and sleek aesthetic.

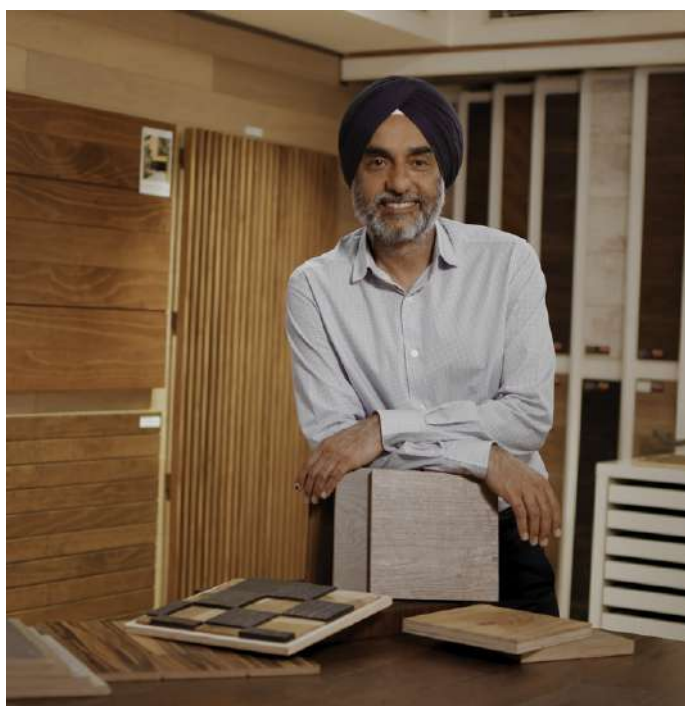
Q. What tips can you give to those who are interested in buying Engineered floors? What few key points should one keep in mind?

Get to Know Your Span Floor



The Span Floors Engineered flooring collection comes with top-of-the-line technical specs for successful day-to-day and long-term usage. At the same time, it will be good to know some key things that will help you make a sound decision as well as get the best out of your investment should you choose to go ahead. Read on ahead for further information

Scratch Resistant

Our engineered floors are finished using high-quality lacquers or hardwax oils, depending on the collection. Generally, lacquered coatings are more scratch-resistant than hardwax oils. At the same time, scratches on hardwax oils are easier to repair. Speak to your Span floors specialist for a recommendation based on your particular needs and lifestyle.



Water Resistant

The high-quality structure in all our floors is strong enough to handle the routine moisture fluctuations found in the air as well as an occasional accidental drink spill. Just wipe off the spill immediately. At the same time, flooding of the flooring or continued seepage of moisture from any source may cause damage to a part or the whole of the floor. In such an event, a few or all of the flooring planks may need to be replaced or sanded and recoated, depending on the situation.



Sound Dampening

World class underlays tremendously affect both in-room as well as below-room acoustics. Using an appropriate underlay such as Elastilon (a layer of thin matt laid under the flooring) can improve the quality of sound tremendously while walking on it with hard heels.



Easy Installation

Our floors come pre-edged with a T & G profile or a click profile for easy installation. You could even take your floor along when you move and refit, depending on the type of installation.





Relative Humidity

Relative humidity or RH is the amount of moisture present in the room air at any given time. This keeps fluctuating during the day and seasonally. Any wood-based material reacts to these changes. You may have noticed that your wooden doors and windows jam a bit during monsoons. This is humidity at work. Similarly, such changes may cause your engineered wood flooring to expand or contract, leading to some creaking noises or gaps between plank joints typically associated with wood floors. While proper installation is helpful in avoiding these to a large extent, sometimes the humidity fluctuations are too large. Keeping the in-room humidity by using air conditioning helps, particularly during monsoons. Similarly, when the air is too dry, some humidification helps. Speak to our teams for some easy tips on how to do this.



Hygienic

The surfaces of our engineered floors are coated with suitable finishes. That makes them hypoallergenic (hypo = low) for most people. Day-to-day cleaning using appropriate cleaners, which are available in stock with us, is generally enough to maintain a high level of cleanliness.



Easy Cleaning

Use a broom or a vacuum cleaner followed by a well-wrung mop, if needed, to take care of the routine cleaning. No special equipment is needed. The use of our recommended cleaning solutions added to fresh water used for mopping will keep your floors in good shape. Our technical and sales team are well-trained to guide you on the appropriate step.



Impact Resistance

Engineered floors are real wood floors. Hence they can be dented somewhat depending on the intensity of the impact. These floors are not fragile though and can mostly take the knocks from day to day life. However high heels particularly not in good repair may cause dents over a period of time. Depending on the thickness of the top layer of your engineered wood floor, it may be possible to renew the entire flooring to a new like condition after many years of usage.

Long Term Maintenance

Being real wood, our engineered floors, may at one time after some years of usage, require a renewer coating or a full sand and recoat to make them look fresh again. Using the specially formulated solutions with appropriate machines can freshen up the wood surface for a more brighter and revitalised finish. Just get in touch with us and our trained specialists will guide you through.





More on Floor Cleaning and Maintenance

Our special cleaners and cleaning kits enable you to clean and maintain your floors in a sweep. Ergonomic and simple to use, the floor cleaning kit is quick to assemble and refill with the specially developed engineered flooring cleaner. Just use the correct kind based on the finish on your Span engineered floor. Forget filling up a bucket and adding concentrate; just spray and clean!

Additionally, you may opt to buy just the Cleaning Concentrate and add the recommended quantity as mentioned on the bottles to the water bucket and use it for day-to-day mopping with a very well-wrung mop.
